Blackstone Chardonnay, Monterey County

6.75/27

This Chardonnay shows aromas of pineapple, peach, lemon citrus with a touch of pleasing oak. The flavors are luscious tropical fruit and a touch of toasted vanilla on the palate. This bright, well-balanced wine has a long, lingering finish.

Kendall-Jackson Vintner's Reserve Chardonnay, California

9.75/39

This Chardonnay bursts with tropical flavors such as mango, papaya and pineapple with citrus notes that explode in your mouth. These flavors delicately intertwine with aromas of green apple and pear to create depth and balance throughout. A hint of toasted oak rounds out the long lingering finish.

Napa Cellars Chardonnay, Napa Valley

9.75/39

This Chardonnay showcases huge fruit flavors reminiscent of tropical fruit, balanced by a layer of lemony acidity and a long, polished finish. Its moderate acidity makes it a more versatile Chardonnay.

Hess Select Sauvignon Blanc, Lake County

8.00/32

This wine begins with floral and citrus aromas, which yield on the palate to flavors of white peaches, pineapple and lemon grass in a medium-bodied, easy drinking style.

Main Street Sauvignon Blanc, Santa Barbara County

5.75/23

This Main Street wine combines both the earthy, melon flavors of warm weather Sauvignon Blanc with the citrus and tropical notes of cooler climate Sauvignon Blanc. It is bright, aromatic, and remarkably refreshing.

Benvolio Pinot Grigio, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy

6.00/24

This Pinot Grigio has delicate nuances of rosewater and lychee on the nose apple and pear flavors on the palate, with a refreshingly crisp and clean finish.

Firesteed Riesling, Oregon

8.00/32

Brimming with the same intense Riesling character of the grapes at harvest, the wine is overflowing with aromas of mandarin orange, honeysuckle, lemon zest and melon.

Murphy-Goode Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

9.75/39

This is a wine that packs a punch, exhibiting flavors of blackberry, black cherry, vanilla and thyme with an oak profile of vanilla and toasted nuts.

Blackstone California Cabernet Sauvignon

6.75/27

Complex with interwoven layers of caramel, ripe plum, and black cherry aromas with a hint of anise, this Cabernet Sauvignon is dry and full-bodied with black cherry and licorice flavors that dominate the palate and carry through to a long, warm finish.

Hogue Columbia Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

6.00/24

The Hogue Cabernet Sauvignon is a full, fruity wine with intense aromas of black cherry, anise and vanilla, flavors of dark fruit, caramel and cocoa, and firm structure.

Blackstone California Merlot

6.75/27

This Merlot is the signature "Blackstone Style" with rich fruit aromas, supple oak characteristics and soft tannins. You'll discover dark cherry and berry aromas with a touch of clove to please the palate. The texture is ripe and soft in the mouth, with a smooth, lingering finish.

Hogue Columbia Valley Merlot

6.00/24

The Hogue Merlot lives up to this reputation and delivers a warm and fruity wine with aromas of crushed raspberry, cherry, and lavender. This robust wine has a core of cranberry and cherry flavors with hints of vanilla and spice.

Carmel Road Monterey Pinot Noir

11.00/44

This is a rich and complex wine, marked by black cherry and roses with warm spice and refreshing raspberry tones on the velvety finish.

Castle Rock California Cuvee Pinot Nior

7.75/31

This wine is elegant and medium-bodied, offering aromas of cherry, tea and herbal spice. On the palate it is smooth with a silky texture and mild tannins, giving flavors of black cherry, plum and spice, and finishing long and harmoniously.

Trinity Oaks Pinot Nior, California

5.75/23

This Pinot Noir is rich with berry and cherry fruit. The wine starts with hints of green tea and mint, and leads to flavors of violets and toasty oak flavors.

Menage A Trois Red, California

7.75/31

This wine exposes the fresh, ripe, jam-like fruit that is the calling card of California wine. Three saucy grapes make up the blend. Zinfandel adds a juicy character, Merlot mellows and Cabernet adds backbone. Forward, spicy and soft, this delicious dalliance makes the perfect trio.

La Crema Pinot Noir, Monterey County

12.75/51

This Pinot Noir has brooding, earthy aromas that meld with juicy ripe plum, punctuated by lovely notes of black tea. The palate echoes the plum-filled nose, joined by black licorice and cocoa powder. A subtle earthiness leads to a generous, fleshy mid-palate and a smooth, mineral-laced finish.
